



Know Your School Rules

1. Reporting time to school for all is 9:00 AM in the morning which has to be strictly maintained. Students would be asked to go back home if they enter school after 9:00 AM.
2. Students must have at least 80% attendance otherwise they would not be allowed to appear for any examinations related to class promotion.
3. Speaking in English in school premises is compulsory.
4. Streaking, colouring, applying henna on hair is strictly not allowed in school.
5. Students need to trim their nails and wearing nail polish or mehendi in hand is strictly not allowed in school.
6. Students should not bring their mobile phone in school.
7. Students must be in proper uniform as mentioned in the school diary. Students not following the same for consecutive 3 days would be sent back home calling the parents. Students should be allowed to wear ankle length White Socks (Primary)/Black Socks (Secondary & H.S) school shoes from reebok/khadim, a simple watch in black and brown band in school. Any expensive ornaments or watches are strictly not allowed in school.
8. Students are not allowed to wear any astronomical rings in school. If at all they need to wear, parents need to furnish a formal letter addressing the same to the principal.
9. Bringing water bottle of a capacity of 1 litre is encouraged. Dry nutritive Tiffin should be given to students during this pandemic time. Parents are earnestly requested not to forget sending lunch with their children when they come to school. The school does not encourage delivering food boxes brought by parents to the students.
10. Students are not encouraged to bring money to school except in case of emergency. The school would not be liable if any child loses her money in school.
11. Students should carry their own medicines along with the prescription in school in case they have any medical issues. Students need to declare the same in the form attached with the diary when it is submitted to the class teacher.
12. It's mandatory that students must know the school songs and prayer and actively participate in school assembly.
