

Kolkata school unveils a special sculpture and hosts event for its 75th anniversary

The unveiling of a bronze sculpture marked a significant milestone for The BSS School as it stepped into its 75th year on January 1 this year. Named The Global Girl, the statue is dedicated to the city of Kolkata. sculpture, cast using the lost wax method, stands on a terracotta brick pedestal, symbolising the soil of the land and West Bengal's traditional art.

Held in the school auditorium, the chief guest at the Platinum Jubilee inaugural event held on January 1 was Justice Amrita Sinha. A tower clock is also being installed on the facade of the school building, and will serve as a landmark on Gariahat.
